- **Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 weighted scale for Regular Admission**

- **Letter of Recommendation**
- **Test-optional:** Paul Quinn is test-optional for the 2022-2023 application cycle. Applicants who have taken the ACT and/or SAT are welcome to submit scores to supplement their applications, but scores will not be required for an application to be considered for admission review.
- **GED students:** A standard score of 170 is required for regular admission, anything below would be considered for conditional admission.

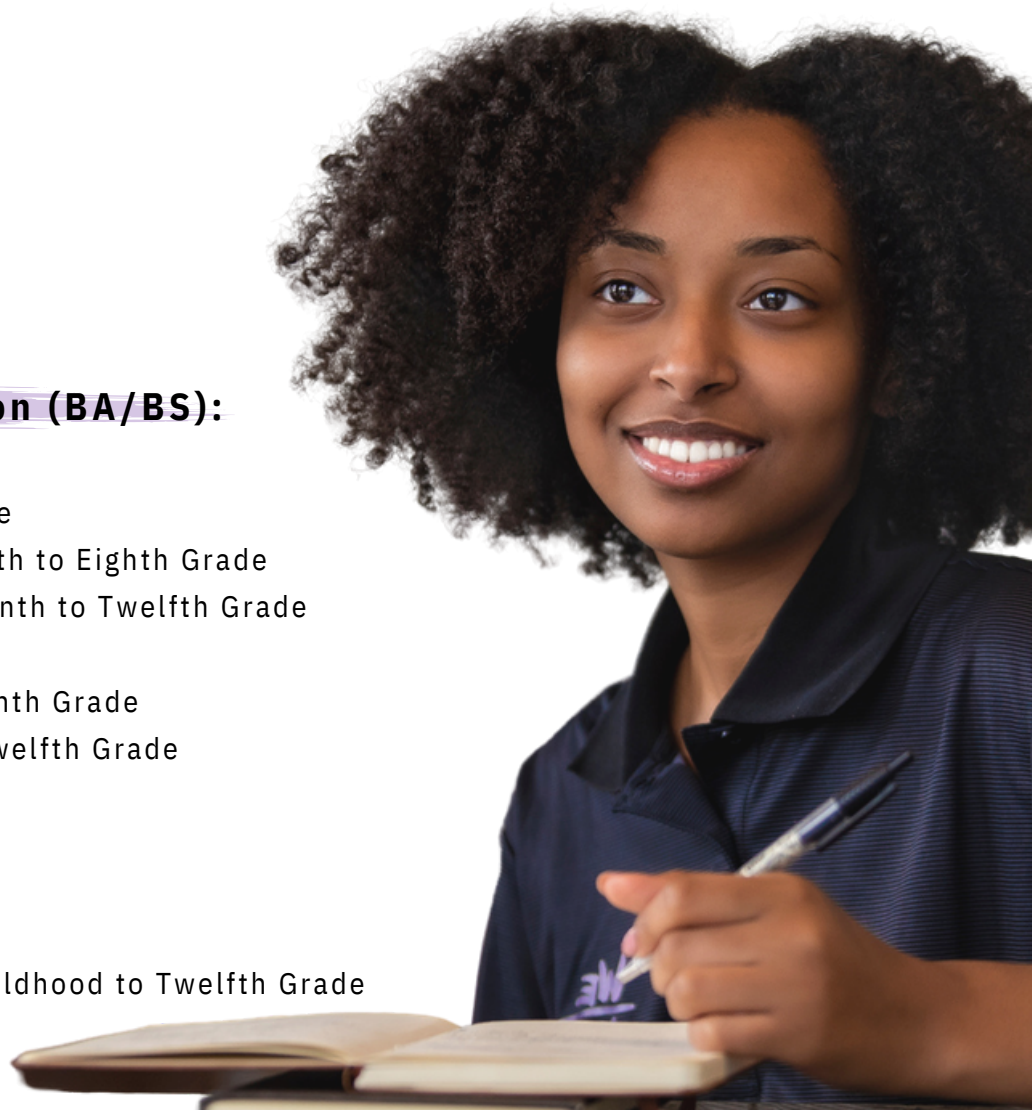

SUMMER BRIDGE

The Summer Bridge program is designed to prepare students for the rigors of college and life in the Quinnite Nation. Every new student is expected to attend and must register by June 1st.

BENEFITS OF SUMMER BRIDGE:

- Earn six to nine college credit hours toward your bachelor degree at Paul Quinn College in just six weeks.
- Get acquainted with our campus and the city of Dallas through fun and interactive events every weekend!
- Learn from Paul Quinn College President Michael J. Sorrell in our signature leadership class, Quinnite Servant Leadership.
- Create strong relationships with your professors, classmates, and staff.

FAQ'S:

- **When is Summer Bridge?**
 - There are two Summer Bridge sessions offered annually.
 - **Summer Bridge Session 1** will begin the **first** week of June.
 - **Summer Bridge Session 2** will begin the **last** week of June.
- **How do I receive financial aid for Summer Bridge?**
 - You must apply for financial aid! The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) opens up every year on October 1st!
 - If you are a Texas resident, and not eligible to apply for FAFSA, you may be eligible to submit the Texas Application for Federal Student Aid (TASFA).
 - School code: 003602
- **How many courses are offered during Summer Bridge?**
 - Summer Bridge 1 will offer 3 courses and students will earn nine 9 credit hours in 6 weeks by successfully completing the program.
 - Summer Bridge 2 offers 2 courses and students will earn 6 credits.

REDUCE STUDENT LOAN DEBT

Over 40 million Americans have student loan debt. The average student debt is \$39,000 and the total loan debt exceeds \$1.7 trillion.

Paul Quinn students graduate with less than \$10,000 in student loan debt. More than half of our students graduate with no debt at all. In addition to federal and states grants, every student that participates in the Work Program receives from \$5,000 to \$15,000 in financial assistance.

MAINTAIN HEALTHY WORK & ACADEMIC BALANCE

Over 75% of today's college students are working more than 24 hours a week while attending school to make ends meet.

Paul Quinn students work 10-16hrs a week in addition to their academic work. Freshmen and sophomores typically work on-campus jobs to get adjusted. Upperclassmen are matched with employers off-campus in their chosen fields.

GAIN REAL WORK EXPERIENCE

61% of all full-time, "entry level" jobs require 3+ years of experience. 50% of college graduates wish they had received more real-world work experience in school.

The Work Program provides students with meaningful pre-professional work experiences that allow them to incorporate their need to work into their overall academic experience and affords abundant opportunities for networking, mentoring, and employment after graduation.

GRADUATE WITH 4-YEARS OF REAL WORK EXPERIENCE

Only about 23% of Hispanic and 16% of African American students are considered college-ready.

Our Summer Bridge Program and Quinnite Arts education model not only empower students for the academic rigors of college, it also serves as a strong foundation to start building workforce skills and knowledge of a global market.
