

## To Qualify:

Must graduate from a Dallas County high school or community college with:

- at least a 3.0 GPA;
- AND either an 18 on the ACT or a combined score of 1000 on the SAT
- OR A in three or more AP courses

Be eligible for the maximum Pell Grant award

## **Requirements:**

- Commit to living off-campus
- Maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA throughout all academic semesters
- Attend PQC's Summer Bridge Program
- Must participate in the College Work Program
- Submit all application materials including FASFA, transcripts, letter of recommendation, and resume
